OSCE Nights

OSCE (Objective Structured Clinical Examination) assessments are an integral part of medical school where students integrate their academic and clinical practice skills in examining simulated patients. These are usually case based, with each case requiring a range of history taking and physical examination skills. To prepare students for these demanding clinical exams, MSSBU runs OSCE nights aimed at years 2, 3 and 4, where senior students mark and share advice. These events attract high number due to the demanding nature of these examinations and play a massive role in preparing students to perform at their best.

AMSA Think Tank & National Council




The Vampire Cup initiative allows students to advocate for a good cause, be active in the community and also meet some new people along the way.


Community Health and Wellbeing


Publications
